DPT, NURSING AND EDUCATION PROGRAMS PASS RATES

PHYSICAL THERAPY

For the Cohort of 2019 (54 students): 8 students did not release their NPTE scores (14.8%); 42 passed the NPTE on the first attempt (77.8%); 5 failed the first attempt (9.5%). 5 passed on their second attempt (100% who retook the test). Follow up was done with the 8 who did not release test results. Matching the Free FSBPT report, the Cohort of 2019 has 100% ultimate NPTE passage.

For the Cohort of 2020 (53 students): 4 students did not release their NPTE scores (7.6%); 42 passed the NPTE on the first attempt (79.3%); 8 failed the first attempt (15.1%). 6 passed on the second attempt. 2 passed on the third attempt. Follow up was done with the 4 who did not release test results. Matching the Free FSBPT report, the Cohort of 2020 has 100% ultimate NPTE passage.

For the Cohort of 2021 (32 students): 5 students did not release their NPTE scores (15.63%); 21 passed the NPTE on the first attempt (65.63%); 11 failed the first attempt (35.5%). 10 of the 11 passed on subsequent attempts. 1 still has not shared test results.

For the Cohort of 2022 (36 students), they will not be eligible for their NPTE exam until January 2023.

Summary of Evidence

The Wheeling University completer mean scores for Praxis I, II, and the PLT all are above the qualifying score for West Virginia. All Praxis I areas presented a range of 88-100% pass rate. Praxis II had similar results with mean scores above the state qualifying score. Overall candidate passing rates ranged from 50-100%. It is to be noted that during the 2020-2021 academic year the West Virginia Department of Education permitted teacher candidates to progress through student teaching without passing praxis scores. Typically, the candidate passing score would be 100% for Praxis I & II because WVDE requires passing scores to receive a student teaching permit. Those students that did not pass the Praxis tests in 2020-2021 have moved to other states seeking initial license in their home state hence they have not reported any further scores to Wheeling University and West Virginia. These scores support the notion that WU completers are prepared in content for the licensure areas they seek.

- The Evaluation Leadership Institute (ELI) is offered by the West Virginia Department of Education. The ELI is not a requirement of the program; however, it is a requirement for WV administrative certification. The ELI is the education and training requirements specified in WV Code §18A-2-12 for evaluation of professional personnel in the public-school system of the state of West Virginia. Leadership candidates provide the ELI completion certificate to the Director as part of the WV administrative certification process.
- The Praxis 5412 and the ELI are appropriate measurement tools as each is required for West Virginia certification.
